

This table can be used to plan for the size and needs of the maternity waiting home and to conduct a cost estimate prior to construction or renovation. Communities should be asked to pledge to provide services and raw materials such as making bricks, hauling sand and gravel, cutting wood, donating labor etc. It has been MWH success is linked to the support of the community – more support means the home is more likely to be successful.

The table below can be used as a planning guide to estimate costs associated with the MWH construction and maintenance.
